# How to contact your legislator

### The Hierarchy of Contact

#### Constituent Coffee / Townhall

Be ready with your comments and background on bills

#### **Email**

Personal messages are most effective.
Personalize any templates



#### Face to Face Meeting

Email your request for a meeting. Make clear who you are and what you want to talk about. A good subject line helps.

#### **Zoom/Virtual Meeting**

Write out your script and talking points ahead of time





How to participate in campaign season

#### Time and Money

- Donate to The Public Health Political Action Committee (PAC)
  - O Bundled donations that send a message / make a clear statement of values
  - Elect more public health champions



More investment in Public Health

- Volunteer or Donate Directly to Candidates
  - Google candidates, use the contact info on campaign website
  - Opposition research, phone banking, canvassing.
  - Write a letter to the editor or Op Ed.





# How to participate in legislative session

### Plug-in, Prepare, & Polish

- Track legislation through OLIS
- Meet with your legislators / commissioners or their staff
- Sign up to testify
  - Be direct and know the facts: cost, importance, affected population, tell a story
  - Break it down / make it simple
- Submit written testimony
- Help write testimony for OPHA & CLHO
- Submit an op-ed or letter to the editor
- Participate in Advocacy Day
