- Recommendations for endorsement:
  - HB 2406 relating to integrated pest management plan for schools

- H.R.804 Federal Family and Medical Insurance Leave (FAMILY) Act
- There are two champions on the committee will follow the bill.

Motion: Strongly endorse H.R. 804 Motion approved.

- HB 2969 relating to oral health in schools
- There is a champion.

Motion: Strongly endorse HB 2969 Motion approved.

 Nathaniel requested to represent OPHA on the LGBTQ+ Aging Coalition. He will send more information to the board.

Motion: Support Nathaniel joining coalition on behalf of OPHA. Motion approved.

- David Huntley asked about the tobacco retail license (TRL) legislation. David requested that
  the committee discuss the bill. Sierra said that CLHO is still moving the bill along. Jessica
  suggested that David complete an endorsement request form. Allison offered her expertise
  on the topic.
- HB 2337 racism is a public health crisis update on current status
  - The bill is being moved to the Rules Committee. House Health Care Committee had too many bills to consider before the work session deadline. HB 2337 moved to Rules Committee along with numerous other bills. HB 2337 would have needed a hearing in Rules anyway.
